Don't miss this opportunity to engage with thought leaders, share your research, and contribute to the growing field of genetic epidemiology.

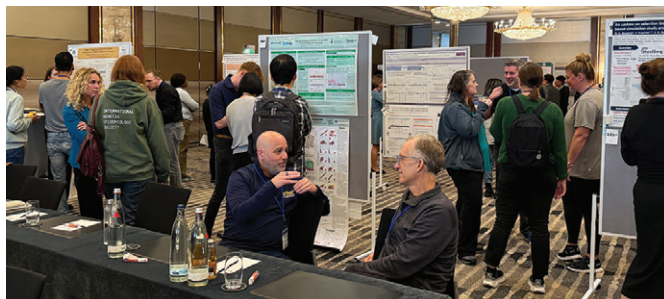
